NAACP ASKS JUSTICE DEPARTMENT To stop "terror" in memphis

INVESTIGATION OF 'OPEN TERROR' IS URGED BY WHITE

NEW YORK—(SNS)—United States Attorney General Robert Jackson was asked Menday by the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People to bring the forces of the Justice Department to bear in an investigation of the open terror being meted out to Negroes in Memphis. Tennessee, by politicians and the local police force of Memphis.

follows:

"The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People protests vigorously against abrogation of freedom of press by Chief of Police of Memphis, Tennessee, who has called in two Negro editors and threatened them if they did not print the kind of news matter and editorials to which he could give his approval regarding general racial situations in the United States.

"According to widely circulated news stories Negro business men in (Memphi's are being harassed b) police and a score of more promitent Negro citizens have been uhreatened with being driven out of town-A **unrest** of **mabhne** "giff warfare is said to have been made by Police Chief Boyle. It is alleged that this entire situation has grown out of the fact that some Memphis Negre citizens in the last election chose to support the candidate not favored by the political boss Ed Crump.

"We believe the situation is grave and calls for immediate investigation and vigorous action by the Department of Justice in all acphases particularly the threat against the freedom of the press."
