

Four States Plan To Deny Vote To Negro Citizens

MONTGOMERY, Ala. — (ANP)—
Four southern states are seeking
copies of Alabama's Boswell amend-
ment, added to the state" constitu-
tion 14 months ago to minimize vot-
ing of Negroes. the amendment's au-
thor revealed this week.

State Rep. E. C. Boswell said
Georgia, North Carolina, South Car-
olina and Texas want copies of the
law as a possibility for them to fol-
low.

His amendment requires pro-
nec- tive voters to be able to "understand
and explain" any part of the U. S.
constitution to the satisfaction of
county registration boards. It also
revealed a constitutional provision
that any person with \$300 worth of
taxable property could vote whether
they could read or write.
