Death On A Sunday In New York

New York police carry stretcher bearing assassinated black nationalist leader Malcolm X after he was gunned down during a Harlem speaking engagement. The 39-year-old former confederate of the Black Muslim movement was pronounced dead on arrival in a nearby hospital. About
