Dames Mark 5th Annual Bal Masque With Elegance

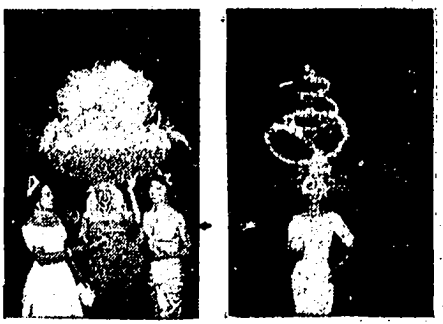
