

# Kidnaped Girl Still Missing

## Citizens Demand Action As Police Fail To Find Clues to Abductor Of Nine Year Old School Child

Dorothy Lee Gordon, 9-year-old school girl, who was assertedly abducted near her home last Tuesday afternoon by an unidentified white man was still missing today as demands continued to flow into the district attorney's office asking for action.

District Attorney Huron Fitts last week issued a statement from his sick bed in a local hospital effecting immediate investigation. Detectives R. E. Spreckel and Claude Robinson have been assigned to the case.

Christina Pollard, 11-year-old playmate of the missing girl told how the girl was lured into the abductor's car on the pretext of a ride home. No license number was

obtained by the girl, who is believed to have been the only eye witness to the abduction. Facts about the kidnapping as related by the young girl were narrowed down to a grey sedan and a bareheaded white man.

"Efforts of social and civic organizations of the city should immediately begin to establish a reward for information leading to return of the child and the arrest of her abductor," stated publisher Leon H. Washington today. "All organizations including churches, lodges, clubs and individuals interested in the safety of our womanhood should rally their financial support," he declared.

Parents of the child, although deeply grieved expressed hope that the child would be returned alive. All or some persons who saw the girl in car last Tuesday are requested to give complete information to the District Attorney's Office or the Los Angeles Sentinel.
