Pap Test Given Free In Bronx

Free exams to detect cancer of the breast and uterus will be available to Bronx women Wednesday, January 13 through Saturday, January 16 in a cooperative venture of the American Cancer Society's Bronx Unit, the Bronx Women's Liberation Health Committee and Fordham Hospital.

All women living or working in the East Tremont-Fordham area of the borough are urged

to attend.

Hours are 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Wednesday, January 13; noon to 4 p.m., Thursday and Friday, January 14 and 15; and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday, January 16 at the Women's Liberation Health Committee, 109 East 184th Street in the Bronx.

Child care will be provided during the examinations by the Women's Liberation Committee.

"The Pap test to detect uterine cancer and the quick and painless breast examination are every woman's best protection against these major forms of cancer," Dr. Marcelle T. Bernard, vice chairman of the Bronx Unit's executive board, said.

"I hope every woman in the area will take advantage of this life-saving opportunity."
