# **Mrs. Amy Garvey To Speak Sunday At Renny Casino**

Mrs. Amy Ashwood Garvey, woman leader of Jamaica, West Indies, and widow of Marcus Garvey, will be the principal speaker at a mass meeting Palm Sunday afternoon at the Renaissance Casino, Seventh Avenue and 138th Street, at 3 p. m.. Dr Charles A. Petioni, chairman of the West Indies National Council, said this week. Mrs. Garvey arrived in the United States about a month ago after an absence of several years.

The theme of the meeting, it was said, is the "Role of the West Indian in the War."

Other speakers scheduled on the program are: Juan Corretjer, editor of PUEBLOS HISPANOS; Marion Bachrach, secretary of the Council for Pan-American Democracy; Charles Collins, of the Negro Labor Victory Committee, and Thelma Dale, of the National Negro Congress.—M.
