WASHINGTON-The Kansas City Monarchs, last Tuesday, took the first game of the World Series, and beat the Washington Homestead Grays 8 to 0, before 25,000 fans at Griffith Stadium.

For five perfect innings, it was a magnificent duel between Roy Welmaker. Gray's lefthander, and the celebrated Satchel Paige. Two fast double-plays, in the second and fifth innings kept Welmaker on the sunny side.
