Daisy Lampkin Lauds Work Of Women

They Are Doing Excellent Work for Hoover-Curtis

Washington, D. C.—Mrs. Daisy E. Lampkin, Director of Women's Activities, Colored Voters' Division (Eastern), announced at Republican National Headquarters today that she is well satisfied with the general attitude of colored women in the States, and their enthusiastic cooperation in support of the Hoover-Curtis ticket.

Key women have been contacted in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware, West Virginia, and Virginia. The Women's Bureau has cooperated with State central committees in the stimulation of colored workers.

Women speakers have been assigned to large meetings through the chairman of the speaker's bureau, George W. Harris. More than 50,000 copies of a pamphlet, prepared by the bureau, and containing questions and answers for the colored woman voter, have been distributed to voters in both the Eastern and Western Divisions.

Women workers in each State report that both town and ward meetings are being held regularly, and contacts are being secured through interviewers and group meetings.

In the States under her supervision, Mrs. Lampkin reports detailed and intensive work in the organization of Hoover-Curtis clubs.

Miss Nannie H. Burroughs, a speaker working with the women's bureau, has just returned from an eight day speaking tour in Kentucky, and one large meeting in Chicago. She reports so much enthusiasm among colored voters that crowds were turned away, and in some instances, outdoor meetings were requested.
